



Additional public trial added to enhance testing of new terminal

Last week, ACAA announced it is adding an additional Public Trial to further test systems and processes in advance of the new terminal opening – and creating the opportunity for more public participation to meet the robust public interest.

The upcoming Public Trial for the new terminal remains scheduled for Sept. 20, and the additional date will be announced within the next few weeks. The additional trial will also be the larger of the two and more advanced, with more terminal systems coming online.

Members of the public were notified last week via email, including those whose schedules will be impacted.

Since this spring, ACAA has conducted single operation (or basic) trials of critical systems in the new terminal and recently began the first series of advanced trials in cooperation with airline and other partners. The public trials will mark significant large-scale operations of the new terminal and will give PIT's Operational Readiness and Transition (ORAT) team a comprehensive view of the building's familiarization and readiness ahead of its scheduled opening this fall.
