PIT team members have been preparing diligently to make the transition to new and modernized airport facilities. That transition is mere months away, though these preparations have been years in the making, starting as early as the design phase of our new terminal and parking complex.

We made a commitment when we embarked on our modernization to keep PIT operational both during construction and as we transition from current to new facilities. Our goal from the start has been to minimize the impact of modernization on passengers, partners and team members. To support us in achieving that goal, we assembled an Operational Readiness, Activation and Transition (ORAT) team for the early stages of the project.

The PIT ORAT team is charged with the transition of new and modernized facilities into operation, which includes testing systems, integrating airport elements and preparing team members for opening day.

The commitment we made to ORAT has set a new standard, advancing operational collaboration, safeguarding efficiency and managing the successful transfer of PIT facilities from design through construction and into operation. Preparing for a seamless transition enhances our resiliency and ensures the successful arrival of the transformed PIT.
