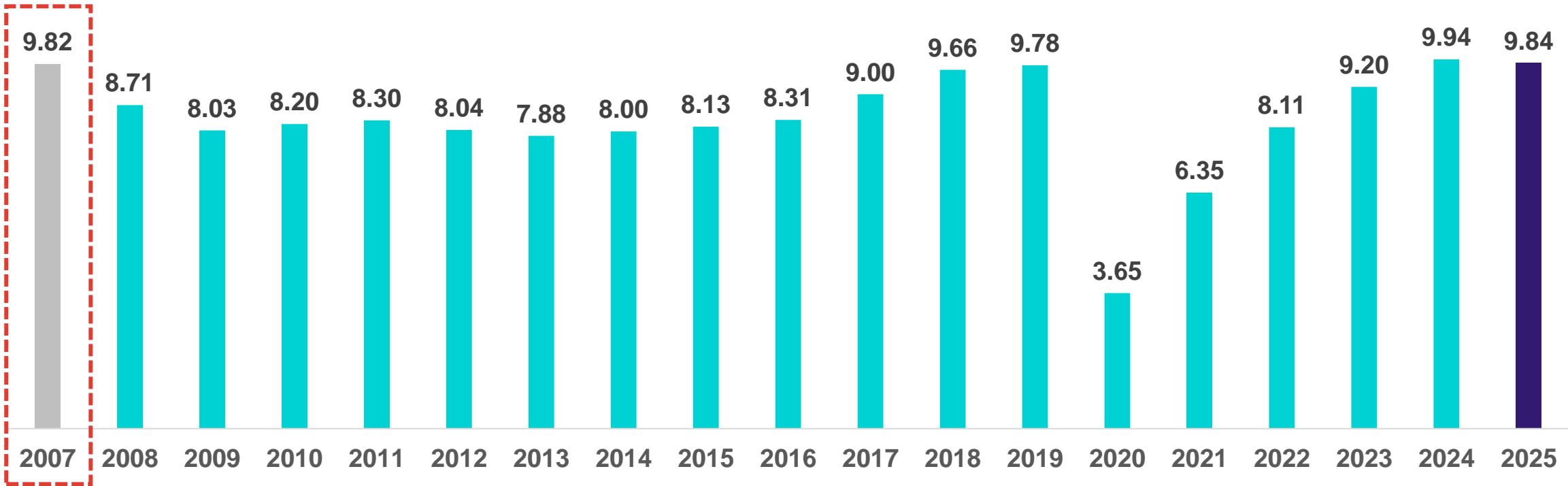

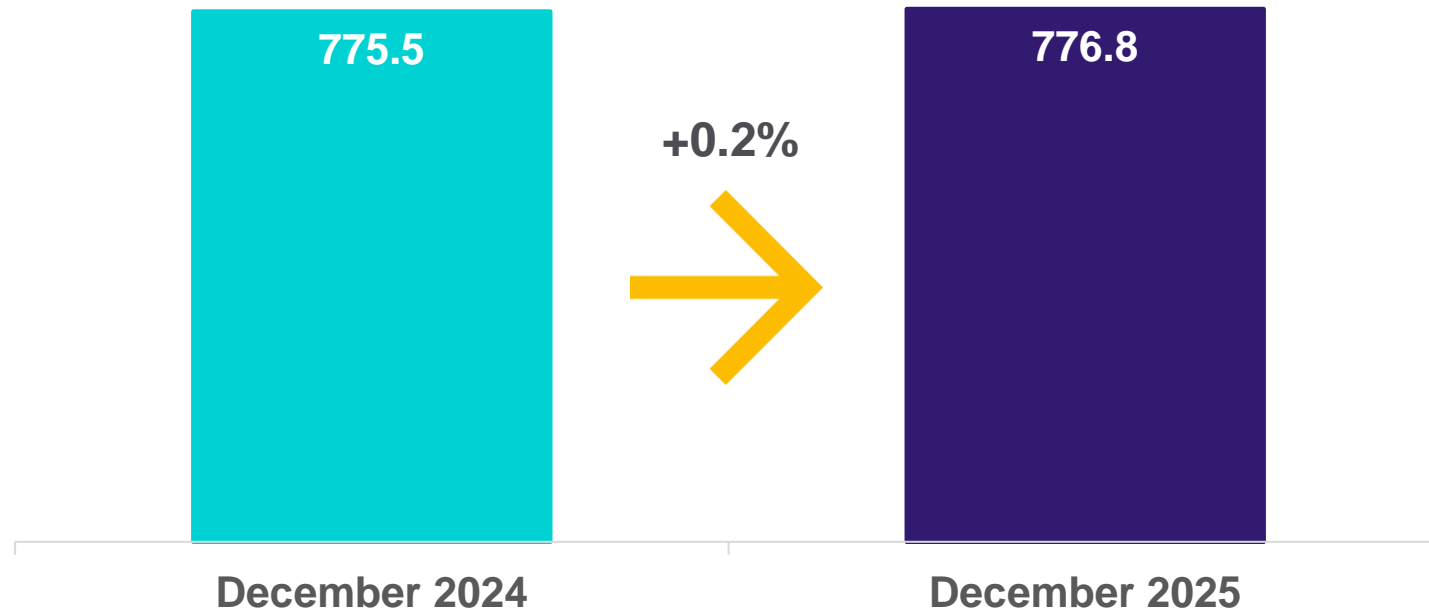
United Airlines will launch daily, nonstop service to Los Angeles (LAX) on March 29

- United will utilize the Boeing 737-800 with 166 seats, including 16 in First Class
- United will now serve all seven of its hubs from PIT
- United last served LAX from PIT in 2014
- United is the third carrier to serve LAX from PIT
 - American and Breeze also serve the market



Passenger traffic increased in December even with a shift in the Thanksgiving holiday

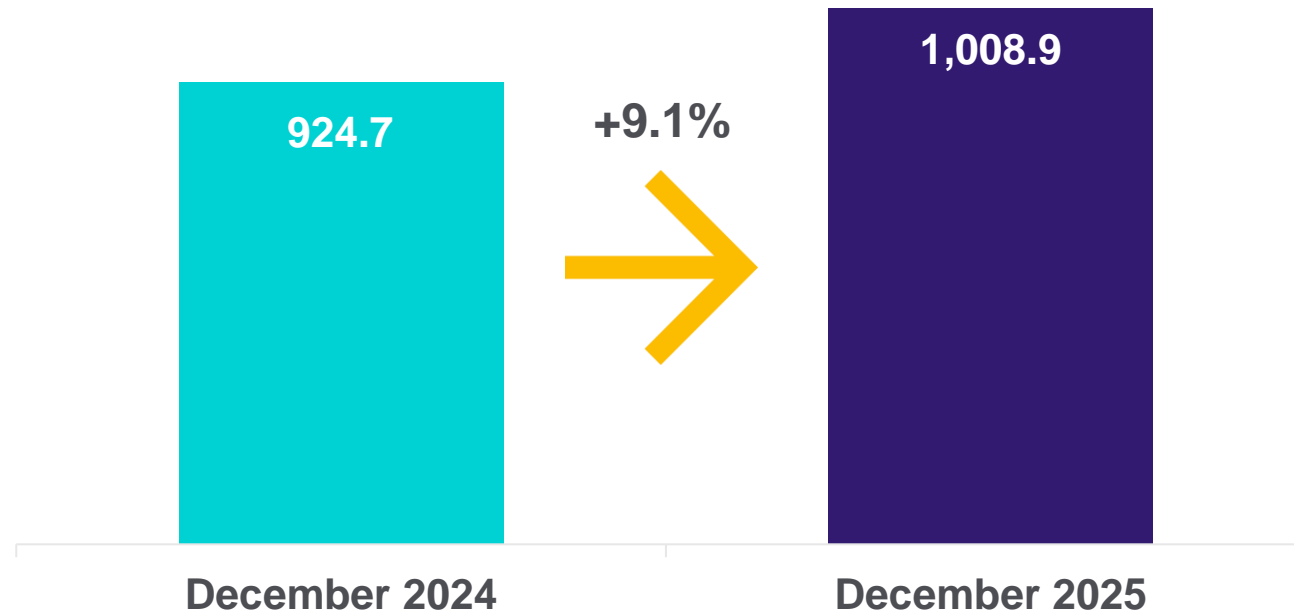
Total December Passengers

Airlines significantly increased capacity at PIT in December to meet holiday travel demand

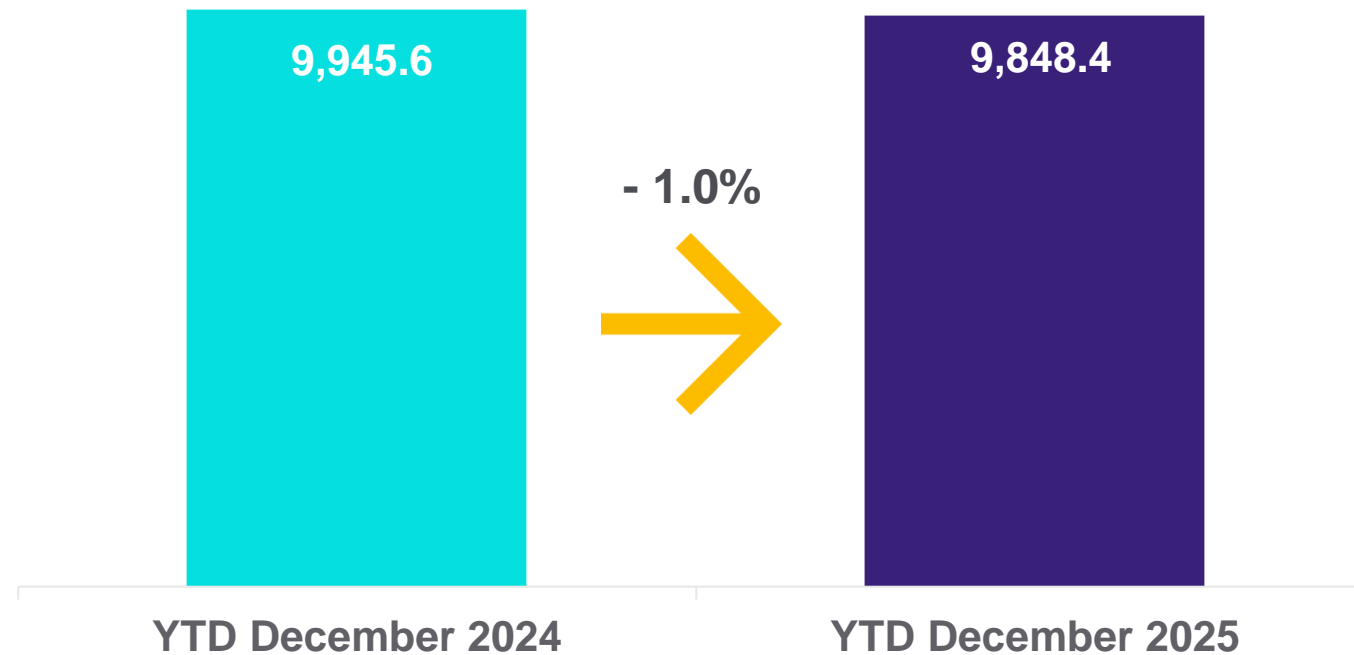
Total December Seats

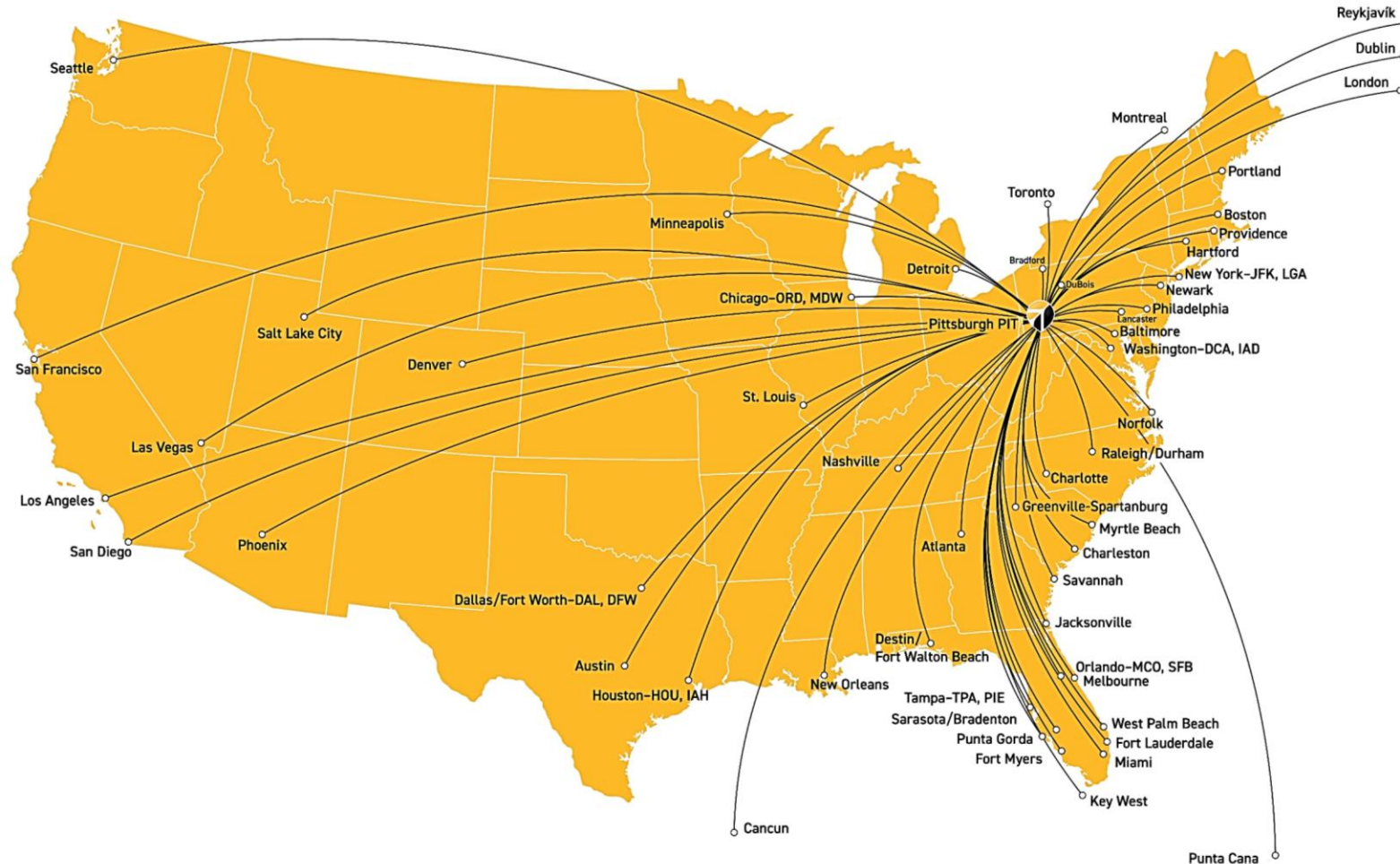
PIT ended 2025 with over 9.8M passengers, nearly equal to 2024's record traffic

PIT now features 16 airlines and three European destinations with the addition of Aer Lingus

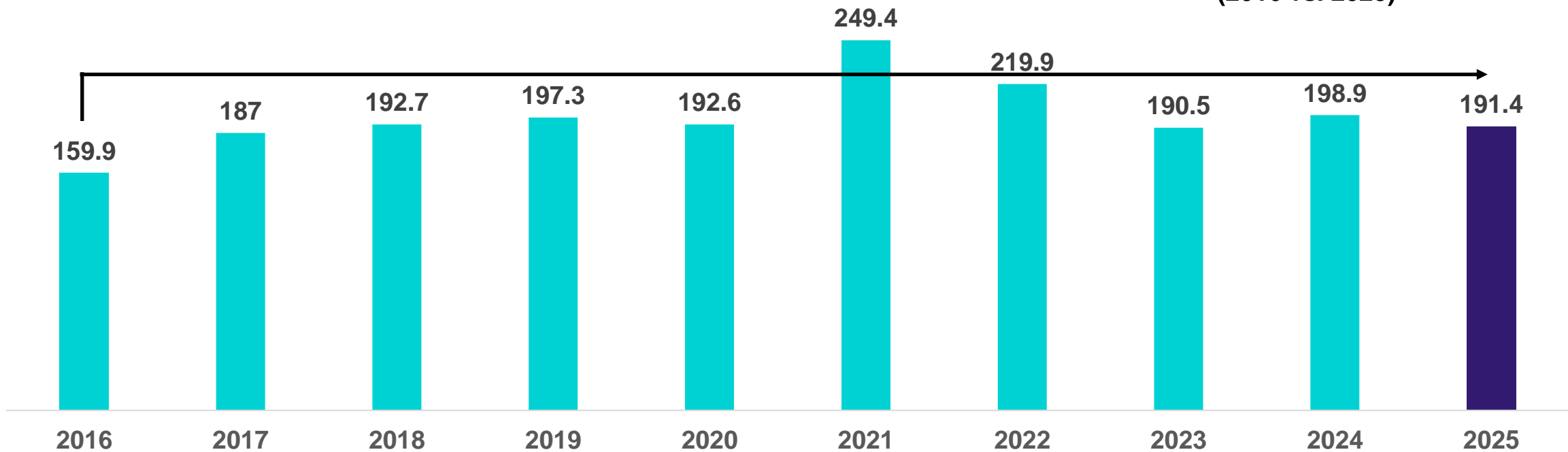


Cargo increased by over 19% in 2025 compared to 2016 – over 191M pounds moved through PIT

(2016 vs. 2025)



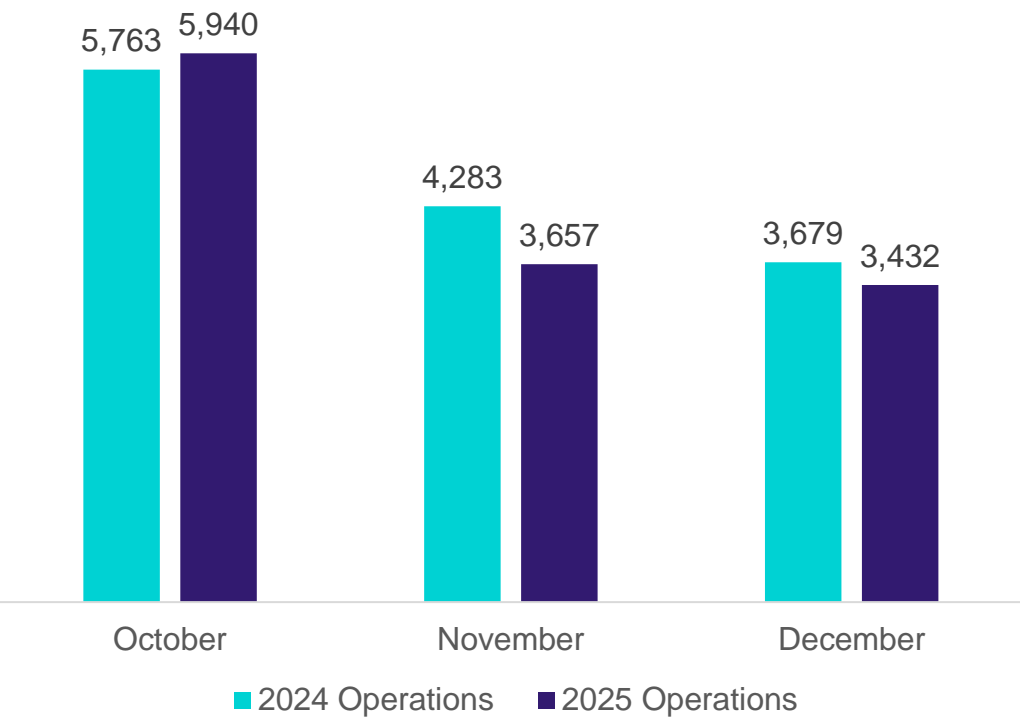

Total Monthly Operations at AGC for Q4

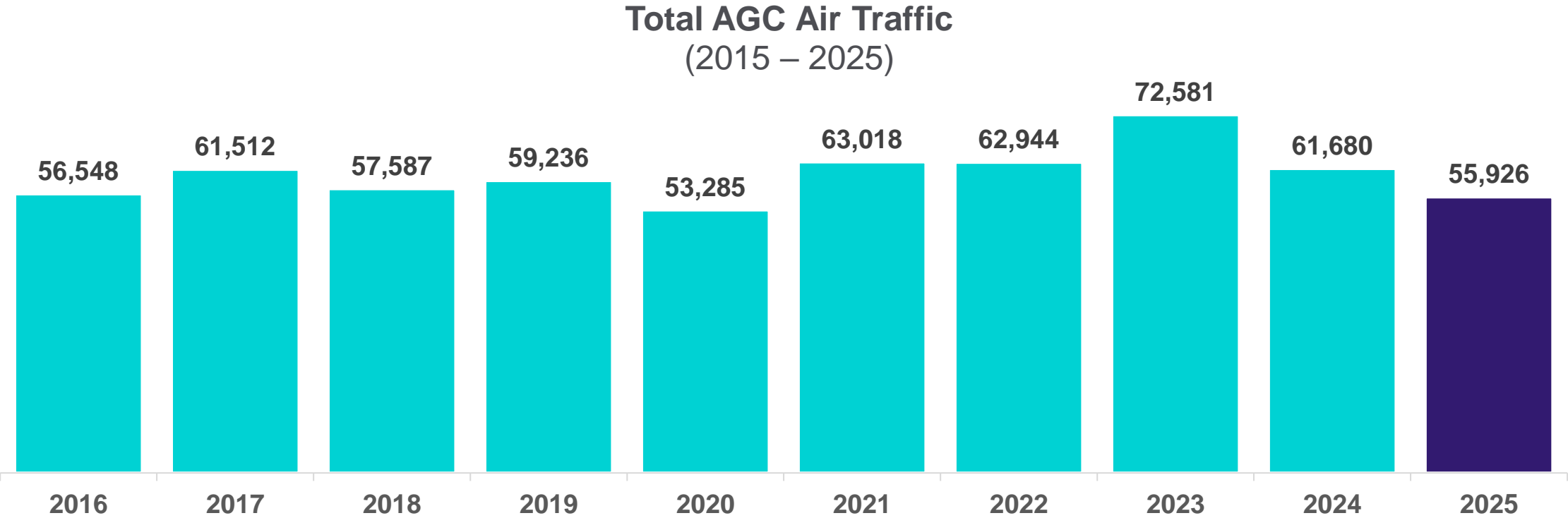

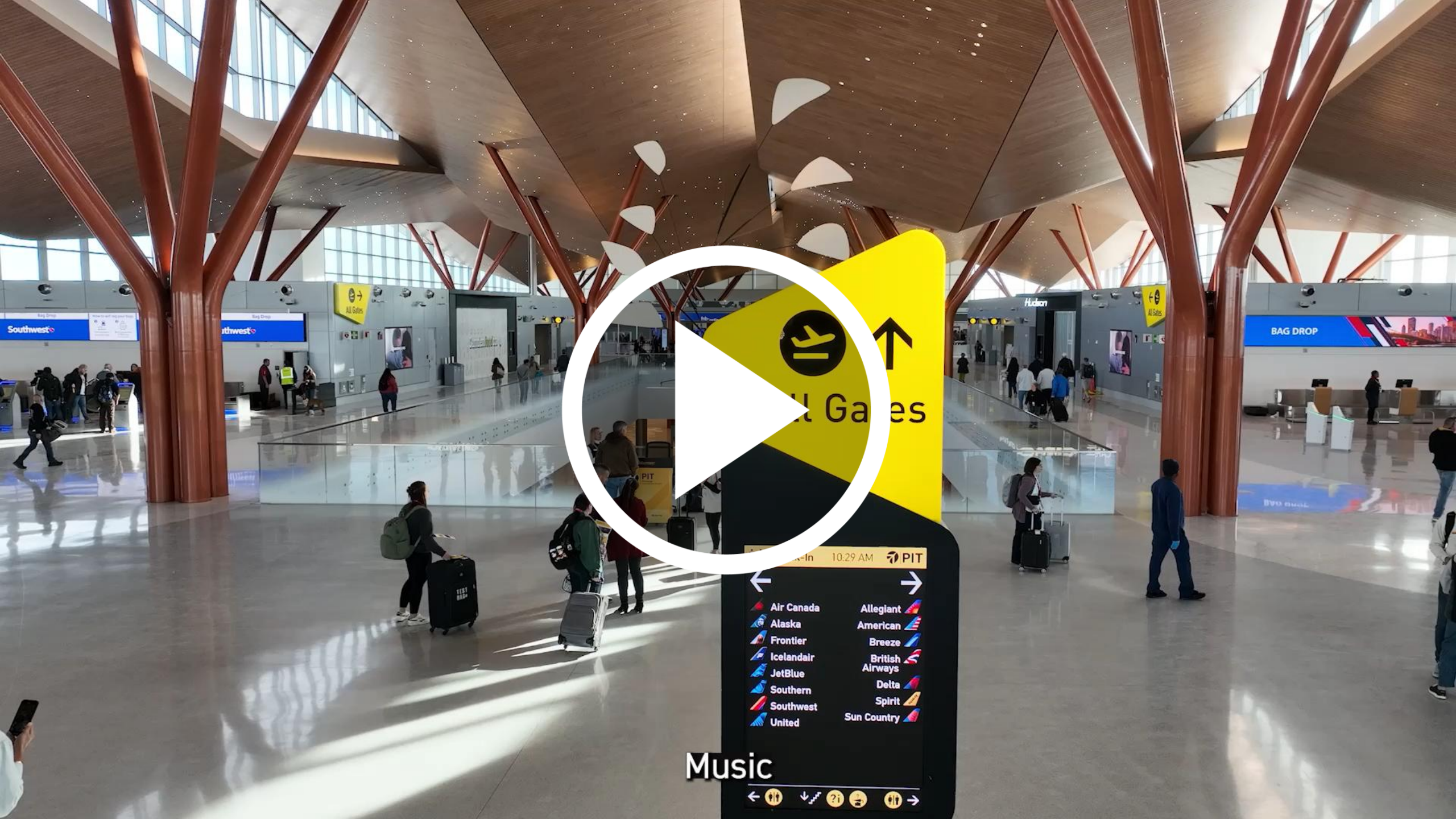
