

New PIT Weekly Update: New FIDs framed with Pittsburgh connection

The transformed PIT is designed to reflect, connect and serve the Pittsburgh region. That means bringing in local artists and craftspeople to infuse a sense of place – a sense of Pittsburgh – into the new landside terminal and throughout a modernized airside.

One of those craftspeople is Jason Boone, owner of <u>Urban Tree</u>, a local, full-cycle woodworking shop. Boone and his team reclaim trees from Pittsburgh's urban forest, shaping them into uniquely beautiful, usable furniture pieces. Those same trees have been transformed into frames for PIT's new flight information displays (FIDS) that will be placed throughout the airport.
