



New PIT Weekly Update: Partnerships drive site visits at modernized PIT

One key to success is to develop partnerships that work. That has been critical to the site walk program that has been part of PIT's modernization project. More than 4,500 people have been on nearly 375 site visits relating to the construction of the new terminal since the formal program began in March 2023.

Soon, even more will participate in operational walk-throughs.

Site walks require significant coordination among multiple organizations to ensure the safety of all participants while at the same time not interfering with construction progress.
