# PIT's diverse air service portfolio supports stability amid Spirit Airlines' adjustments






- Spirit Airlines recently filed for its second bankruptcy – guests may continue to book flights without interruption
- Spirit Airlines is PIT's fifth largest carrier, currently serving six destinations
- Spirit Airlines has carried over 6% of PIT traffic year-to-date through August 2025
- Spirit Airlines remains an important part of PIT's network, while other carriers also serve the same destinations, ensuring continued choice for travelers

# PIT's July 2025 year-to-date traffic decreased following similar trends at peer airports




# Passenger traffic decreased year-over-year in both July and August 2025





# Airline capacity declined in both July and August 2025, primarily due to reductions by Spirit Airlines






# PIT has served over 6.5 million passengers in 2025 year-to-date, a 1.9% decrease from 2024



Total Year-to-date Passengers (YoY, Thousands)







# AGC is a preferred airport for corporate fleets and private pilots


